This term we have chosen to support the Dougie Mac. I am sure many of you will know of the wonderful work of the Dougie Mac who provide end of life care and support when needed. Personally, I have experienced first-hand the wonderful work of this charity one that as a family we will be forever grateful to as they were there to care, support and comfort in our time of need.

On Tuesday 24th October we will be holding a **disco** after school. The charge to attend the disco will be **£2 per child**. Children can wear their own clothes to the disco and can be left in our care but will need to be collected promptly at the end of their session.

On Friday 27th October we will be holding a coffee morning for parents from 9am -10am in the school hall a selection of cakes and drinks will be available with all funds raised going to the Douglas Macmillan.

This may be a pair of yellow socks, yellow wellies a yellow t-shirt or a full yellow outfit. It really does not matter! We will be asking **children to pay £1** to dress in yellow with all funds going to the Dougie Mac.

We will also hold a sunflower gift stall on the playground at the end of the day.
