## Admission to Primary School September 2024

The application process for a place at Primary School (Reception class) has opened and will close on the 15<sup>th</sup> January 2024. If your child's fifth birthday is between 1 September 2024 and 31 August 2025 then you need to apply for a place. If your child currently attends our Nursery Class or your children have brothers or sisters wanting to join in September 2024 you will still need to apply for a place online.
