What is First Holy Communion?

- First Holy Communion is the third Sacrament. It is a Sacrament on initiation but once the Sacrament is received it can be received weekly.
- The children will receive the body and blood of Christ (the bread and wine) This unites us with God.



Reconciliation

- Before the children receive First Holy Communion they must receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation (Confession) to cleanse and heal and bring us closer to God.
- This is a Sacrament of Healing.
- Again this is a Sacrament that once the children have received for the first time they can receive again and again (e usually go during Lent and Advent as a school)



What do you need to do?
