

Dear Parents,

I wrote to you last week about our wall in the Reception Class. We had been informed that works would be completed by today (Friday). Unfortunately, when the plaster was removed from the wall further issues became apparent that need extensive works. At present we do not have a full timeline for these works.

It will therefore be necessary for **Reception Class Children to continue to work on the left hand side of the school hall.** All of their equipment and resources have been moved with them so that they can continue to access the full curriculum. We are asking for **Reception Class Children Only to continue to be dropped off and collected from the main Black Hall Doors.**

It will also be necessary for Year 5 and Year 6 Children to continue to eat their lunch in their classrooms next week and this will be served to them.

There may still be some disruptions to PE lessons next week if the children are not able to go outside due to bad weather as the hall will not be available.

All other classes and Before and After school clubs will continue to run as normal.

I am very sorry that I am having to relay this information to you as I know it is not the news that any of us want to hear. I am very unhappy with the current situation, it is far from ideal and I wish to assure you that I have raised this to the highest levels. Thank you for bearing with us as this time. I will continue to keep you informed and share any timelines of works with you as they are received. Presently we do not have an adequate resolution or timeline in place for the completion of these works and we continue to urge those concerned with the PFI contract to ensure a prompt completion of these works.
